A Record of Accomplishments

- :: Championed construction of *six new green buildings* including the newly renovated Cambridge Rindge and Latin School and the Public Library.
- :: As Co-Chair of the Healthy Children Task Force, led Cambridge to become a national model for *healthy eating and physical activity for kids*, developing a *healthy playgrounds* initiative.
- :: Promoted *local food and gardening*, adding new *community garden plots*, an annual *agricultural fair* in Harvard Square, and a city Food Policy Committee.

- :: Expand *support services for children and families*, especially to promote success in school.
- :: Promote zoning and planning to *create and protect robust retail areas* throughout the city.
